



Construction Update

West Rutland Paving Project

Routes 4A and 133

Date: Friday, 6/26/20

Project Location: Roadway

Location: Beginning at the intersection of VT-133 (Clarendon Ave.) and Skyline Drive extending northerly along VT-133 (Clarendon Ave) to its intersection with VT-4A (Main Street). The project also begins west of the intersection of VT-4A (Main Street) and Barnes Street at the Class 1 Town Highway limit and extends easterly along VT-4A (Main Street) to its intersection with BUS-4.

Scope of Work: Construction activities include milling (grinding) of the roadway, paving with a leveling and wearing course of asphalt, pavement markings. Sidewalk ramps and pedestrian crossing infrastructure will be replaced and upgraded to meet current ADA standards as necessary. Some bicycle features may be added where applicable and feasible, and other highway related items will be completed as well.

As part of Governor Scott's "Work Smart, Stay Safe" order, all construction crews are currently subject to safety restrictions and precautions.

Construction Activities:

Shoulder work and berm removal is scheduled throughout the week next week.

Crews are scheduled to remove the median islands located in front of the Price Chopper plaza next week.

Work on sidewalk ramps has been scheduled to begin next week.

Holiday: In observance of the Fourth of July holiday, the contractor will cease operations at Noon on Thursday, 7/2 and will not be working on Friday, 7/3. Work will resume on Monday, 7/6 at 7:00 AM.

Traffic Impacts: Motorists can expect a one-way alternating traffic pattern in the vicinity of active construction operations. Expect delays, particularly in the vicinity of the traffic medial removal near the intersection of Routes 4 and 4A.
