



Construction Update

West Rutland Paving/Intersection Project [Business Route 4 and VT 4A]

DATE: Friday, 8/21/20

PROJECT TYPE: Roadway

LOCATION: This project begins at the US-4 and BUS-4 intersection in West Rutland and heads east along BUS-4 to the Class 1 Town Highway limit in front of the Rutland Town Clerk's Office (MM 0.997). The total project length is 3.094 miles. The intersection project is located in the town of West Rutland at the intersection of Business Route 4 and Vermont Route 4A (near the Price Chopper Plaza).

SCOPE OF WORK: Construction activities include coarse milling (grinding) of the roadway, paving with a leveling and wearing (final) course, intersection reconfiguration (removal of the jughandle), traffic signal improvements, reconstruction of an at-grade railroad crossing, guardrail, pavement markings, signs, drainage rehabilitation and other highway related items.

As part of Governor Scott's "Work Smart, Stay Safe" order, all construction crews are currently subject to safety restrictions and precautions.

ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES, WEEK of 8/24:

The new traffic signals at the intersection of Business Route 4 and Route 4A have been installed. The signals will not be operational at this time.

Paving of the final (also called 'wearing') course of asphalt is scheduled to begin on Monday, 8/24. Paving will begin on Business Route 4 at the Rutland City/Rutland Town line and progress to the west. Please expect delays all week.

Installation of new overhead signs will continue next week. One sign will be located near the jug handle and the other between the bypass and the junction of Route 4 and Route 4A. Shoulder closures will be required in these areas and should not have an impact on traffic.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

One-way alternating and/or flagged traffic patterns will be in effect in the vicinity of paving operations. Please expect delays throughout the week of 8/24 and add extra time to your travel plans.
