

SCAVENGER HUNT WEST RUTLAND HISTORY

- **WHO** This is open to anyone who would like to find out more about West Rutland history, including individuals, families and children, and have some fun while doing so.
- **WHAT** The West Rutland Historical Society is sponsoring a summer-long historical scavenger hunt. A list of things and places to find will be available at the Town Hall, the West Rutland Library and also at the West Rutland School office.
- **WHEN** You can explore from now until September, all summer long.
- **HOW** When you locate one of the things or places on the list, take a picture if possible or document in a notebook anything on the list that is no longer in existence. Some of the items on the list can be found on the internet or in the W. R. Library. Another good source of information will be in various books that have been published by the Historical Society. These will be available at the Town Hall as well as at the West Rutland Library.
- **WHY** The two main reasons for why to get involved in this hunt are: 1. have some fun and 2. learn some interesting town history. At the end of the hunt when you've found all the required information, turn your pictures and written material into Rene at the West Rutland Library or to Stan at the Town Hall.
