Screenings:

Our district provides free early childhood screening for all children ages 3 and 4. Please Note, This is for ALL GRCSU children. Screening at age 3 is preferred, but a child may be screened between the ages of 3 and the start of kindergarten. This is an opportunity to have your child's development screened to assure optimal learning. The district encourages all families to make an appointment for their child. All children in the district are encouraged to attend prior to kindergarten entrance. Screenings will be available at each school in our district to include Middletown Springs Elementary, Poultney Elementary, Proctor Elementary, Rutland Town School, Wells Village School and West Rutland School. Please be sure to make an appointment for your child's screening at the school in the town you reside in.

What to expect at a screening appointment:

A trained professional(s) will check:

- Large and small muscles (fine motor and gross motor skills)
- Thinking, language and communication skills (Cognitive and Language skills)
- Social and emotional development.
- OT/PT/Speech may be present to assist with screening.
- Bring any questions you have about your child's growth and development.
