Below you'll find answers to our most frequently asked questions.

T-Ball & Mighty Mites

Q: When does the season start?

A: Expected to begin at the start of May (pending coaches' needs).

Q: How often will they practice?

A: 2 days per week for 1 hour each day.

Q: What days and times will practices be held?

A: Exact schedule will depend on coaches and will be shared as soon as it's finalized.

Q: Does my child need cleats?

A: Cleats are optional — your child can wear them if they'd like.

Q: What can I expect from this program? My child has never played.

A: No experience is necessary! This program teaches fundamentals in a fun, supportive, and encouraging environment. Skills include throwing, catching, hitting, and teamwork. At the end of the season, we'll participate in low-pressure games with surrounding towns, giving players a chance to apply their skills in a friendly setting. The goal is confidence, skill development, and, most importantly, a positive experience for every child.

Minors & Majors Baseball

Q: When does the season start?

A: Expected to begin mid to late April, weather permitting.

Q: What are the practice days?

- Minors Baseball: Tuesday & Thursday
- Majors Baseball: Monday, Wednesday & Friday

Q: What time are practices?

A: Times depend on coaches' availability and will be shared once finalized.
