Article 7

Shall the voters of the Quarry Valley Unified Union School District approve the school board to expend \$21,927,468 which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? The Quarry Valley Unified Union School District estimates that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in per pupil education spending of \$11,740, which is 4.91% higher than per pupil education spending for the current year.
