

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
WEST RUTLAND PLANNING COMMISSION (PC)**

On **WEDNESDAY, April 15, 2026**, starting at **6:00 pm**, in **Town Offices at 35 Marble St. W. Rutland Village**; the Planning Commission will convene a Public Hearing to receive Public Questions and Comments on updating the current Town Flood Hazard Regulations to include River Corridor development, and other language required to improve the Town's FEMA ratings, so to receive the maximum VT and Federal assistance following a flood or related natural disaster.
